Friday, Saturday and Sunday, April 23-25, 2010

Team Meet - Please note, that we do NOT convert times from yards to meters. If your child has not swum an event long course, the coaches will enter an appropriate time.

- SANCTION:** Held under the sanction of USA Swimming # 2010-044
- LOCATION:** University of Denver, El Pomar Natatorium, 2201 E. Asbury, Denver, CO 80208
- PARKING:** From I-25: take University exit south from the highway and make your first turn east onto Buchtel Blvd. Parking will be available on the north side of Buchtel Blvd. Parking lot is named 108. **MAP INCLUDED-Coaches please distribute map and permit to your team BEFORE the meet.**
- FACILITY:** The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming; 8 lane, 50 meters, with non-turbulent markers. Pool is 4 ft deep on the South end, and 13 ft deep on the North. Meet will be conducted in 7 lanes competition, with 1 lane continuous warm-up/down. No buffer lane. Chase starts will be used to allow a greater number of participants.
- TIMING:** Colorado Timing System with touch pads, back-up buttons and electronic scoreboard. Hy-Tek Meet Manager software.
- RULES:** Current USA Swimming and CSI rules shall govern the conduct of the meet. Age of swimmer is determined as of April 23, 2010. Swimmers are limited to four (4) individual events per day. **ALL EVENTS WILL BE SWUM FASTEST TO SLOWEST.** The meet will be pre-seeded except for events 3-6, 17-18, 29- 30, 41-42, 55-56 which will require a positive check-in. There will be a \$20 penalty for any athlete who checks in for an event and then does not compete. **If you fail to check in you may not be allowed to compete in that event.** Payment must be received before the athletes can resume competition. On Friday evening, the 12 & Under 400 Free and the Open 800 Free will be swum alternating girls and boys. **We reserve the right to limit the both the 400 Free and 800 Free to the fastest 28 or 35 entrants to keep the meet within a reasonable timeline for Friday evening's session. No refunds will be given if an athlete does not get to compete.** A pre-scratch psych sheet will be posted on TOPS website by Monday April 19. Swimmers must provide their own timers and counters for the 400 Free, 400 IM and 800 Free events. All events are timed finals. **NT ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.** TOPS Athletes will be exempt from qual times. At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athletes members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. All swimmers at the meet with out a coach must report to the Meet Director or Meet Referee to make arrangements for such supervision. The meet referee will be the final authority for conduct of the meet.
- START PROCEDURE:** All starts will be conducted under Rule 102.14 (National Start Rules)
- SCORING:** No Scoring
- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all USA member athletes holding current registration. We will post any membership exceptions on our website by Monday April 19, 2010. If swimmers listed on exceptions report cannot provide a current USA membership card on arrival to the meet, they will be required to complete a USA membership registration, and pay the \$56 registration fee, plus a \$27 deck registration surcharge.

ENTRY FEES:

\$3.50 per event
\$5.00 meet surcharge
\$11.50 team surcharge

LATE ENTRIES:

Individual events will be \$5.00, and will be accepted only at meet director's discretion. Events will not be re-seeded.

AWARDS:

Individual Events: Medals for 1st-3rd, and ribbons for 4th-8th for the 8 & Under, 9-10, and 11-12 girls and boys divisions. These age groups will be swum together, but awarded and scored separately. No individual awards for Open age group.

RESTRICTIONS:

Smoking or the use of other tobacco products is prohibited inside DU, or in areas frequented by swimmers.

SPECTATOR SEATING:

The bleachers are a viewing area only. There will be specific areas designated for extended seating in the adjacent concourse, and/or adjacent gymnasium. This policy is created to allow all spectators the opportunity to watch their children compete, please adhere to it at all times.

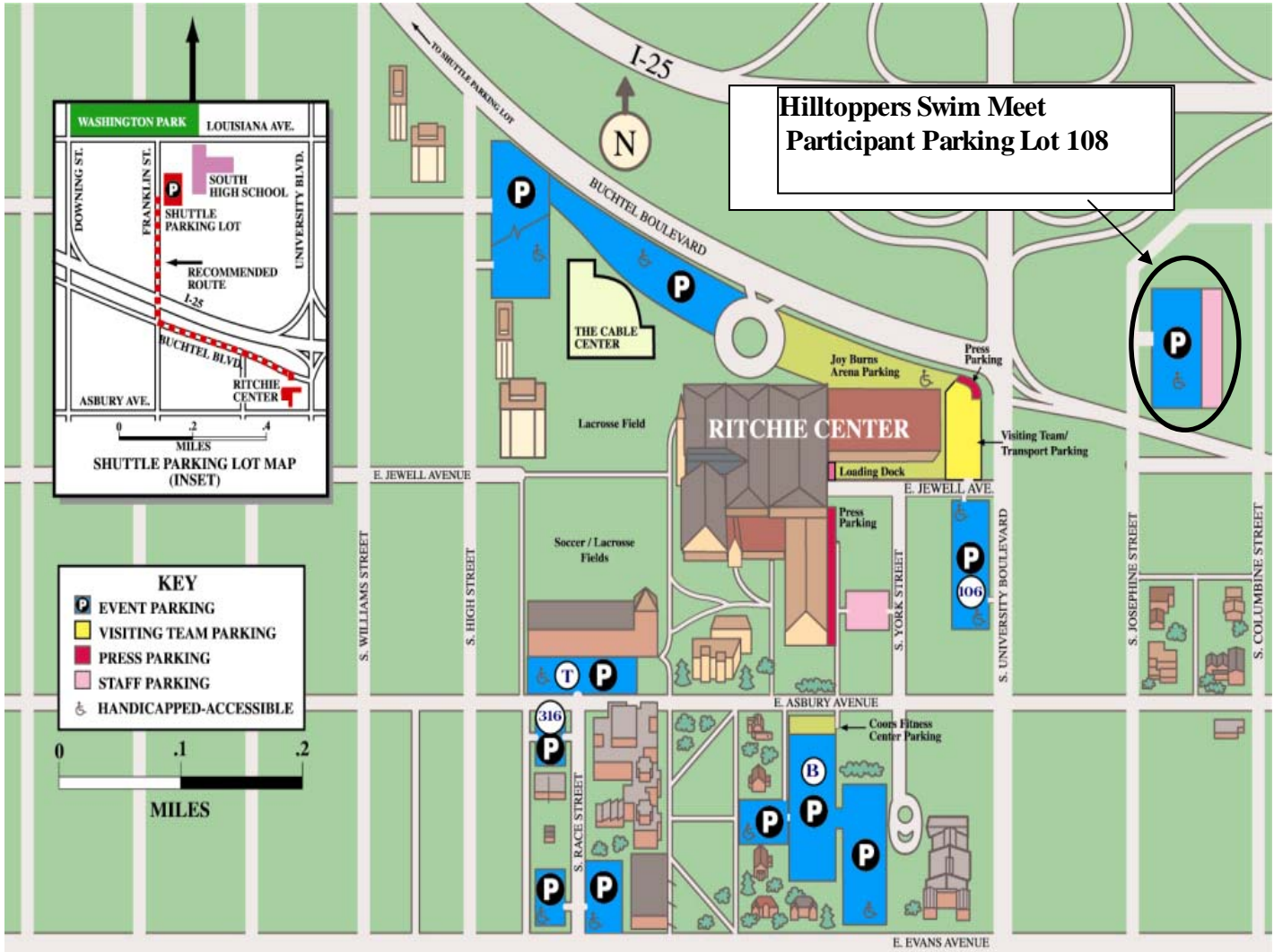

Event Parking Permit Restrictions

Please Read Carefully

1. This permit is for **EVENT PARKING** on the day of your athletic event, concert, and event at the Ritchie Center.
